OVERVIEW

Damaged airports in the Latin American/Caribbean region have a tremendous effect on the local community and the whole country, crippling the efforts to get in badly-needed goods and aid. C-PReP saves lives during times of disaster by preparing airports and communities to become more resilient before disasters strike, thus accelerating the response time and delivery of humanitarian aid. C-PReP includes:

- Pre-assessment of emergency and resiliency plans. •
- Initial on-site screening & assessment.
- Targeted capacity building.
- Incorporation of best practices & guide to address gaps.
- Development of airport-specific implementation plan.
- Review of stakeholders and mutual aid relationships.
- Disaster readiness drill with stakeholders & essential personnel.
- Post-evaluation of the downstream effectiveness.
